



Invitation to Bid

Richmond County, Virginia

February 5, 2019

On behalf of the Northern Neck Planning District Commission (NNPDC), Friends of the Rappahannock (FOR) is soliciting bids from qualified contractors to install a hybrid living shoreline project on a single family, residential property in Richmond County, Virginia. The purpose of this project is to prevent shoreline erosion, improve water quality, and improve habitat for fish and wildlife. The bid should only include estimates for the living shoreline components and not the pier included in the JPA and drawings.

This project is funded in part through a grant from the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation (NFWF) Chesapeake Bay Small Watershed Grant Program and the Northern Neck Planning District Commission.

Friends of the Rappahannock and Northern Neck Planning District Commission reserve the right to reject any or all bids, to waive irregularities and technicalities, and to request re-bids. Withdrawal of bids due to error shall be according to Section 2.2-4330.B.2 of the Virginia Public Procurement Act.

Any individual bid that exceeds \$100,000 is required to be accompanied by a 5% Bid Bond. Also, a 100% Payment and Performance Bond shall be provided by the successful bidder before signing the contract.

Local, minority-owned, and female-owned firms are encouraged to respond.
